

SUBMISSION REGULATIONS FOR THE V EGAS MONIZ SCIENCE DAYS (EMSD)

“One Health & Science - Partnerships for the implementation of goals”

The works must be original and conducted within the pedagogical scope/community interaction/social responsibility or scientific (laboratory/clinical) areas.

The EMSD presentations include three formats:

- Electronic poster (submitted to EMSD in PDF format), infographics are included in this format;
- Paper poster with oral presentation for those who wish to participate in the competition; in this case, the paper poster must be posted in the designated location, and the presentation will take place on the day of the corresponding study cycle; this poster must also be submitted to EMSD in PDF format beforehand;
- Oral presentation (works proposed for oral presentation may be turned into posters at the suggestion of the scientific committee).

RULES FOR WORK SUMMARY SUBMISSION (in Portuguese or English)

(Ensure all fields of the form on the website <https://jem.egasmoniz.edu.pt> are filled in)

1. All works are submitted through a form on the EMSD website;
2. Author and co-author names;
3. Title, with a maximum of 12 words;
4. Select the type of presentation: "poster without competition," "poster in competition," or "oral communication," and the authors must indicate their preferred presentation type, subject to approval or suggestion of change by the Scientific Committee of the corresponding Study Cycle;
5. Select the main scope of the work: "Pedagogical," "Social Responsibility and Community Interaction," "Scientific Research," and "Clinical Case," and follow the form's instructions;
6. Summary in Portuguese or English, as follows:
 - Scientific research works (maximum of 250 words) should include the following items: Introduction; objectives; materials and methods; results; conclusions; clinical/epidemiological relevance; sources of funding (if applicable);
 - Clinical case studies (maximum of 150 words) should include the following items: Clinical case description; discussion; conclusions, and sources of funding (if applicable);
 - Other types (maximum of 250 words) should include the following items: Introduction, development, and conclusions, as well as sources of funding (if applicable); in the case of infographics, only the topic addressed and its objective may be required.
7. Keywords: 3-6 keywords in Portuguese or English;
8. Authors must accept the terms and conditions outlined in the privacy policy, as well as indicate whether or not they allow the work to be published in an e-book;
9. All first authors must be registered for the conference;
10. If any unforeseen event prevents the presenting author from attending, they must inform the executive committee (submissaoapjem@egasmoniz.edu.pt) and indicate a co-author replacement, who must also be registered for the conference;
11. Only works submitted through the website will be accepted.

12. All authors of presentations involving biomedical research on human subjects are responsible for adhering to the highest ethical principles, in accordance with the Declaration of Helsinki.

ACCEPTED WORKS IN POSTER FORMAT

The poster must include:

1. A photograph of the author in the upper right corner (optional);
2. Logos of the Egas Moniz School of Health and Science and the conference in the upper left corner;
Note: The logos will be made available on the conference website.
3. The presenting author's name underlined;
4. Names of the author(s) and co-author(s) with their respective affiliations (specifying the course and whether they are students or faculty);
5. Vertical orientation in A0 format.

Posters will be presented on the day indicated in the conference program. The presenting author will be notified by the Executive Committee of the time and day of their presentation, for which they will have 5 minutes.

ACCEPTED WORKS IN ORAL PRESENTATION FORMAT

Oral presentations, lasting 12 minutes with an additional 3 minutes for questions, will take place on the day corresponding to the panels of the respective course. The presenting author will be informed by the Executive Committee about the schedule for their presentation.
